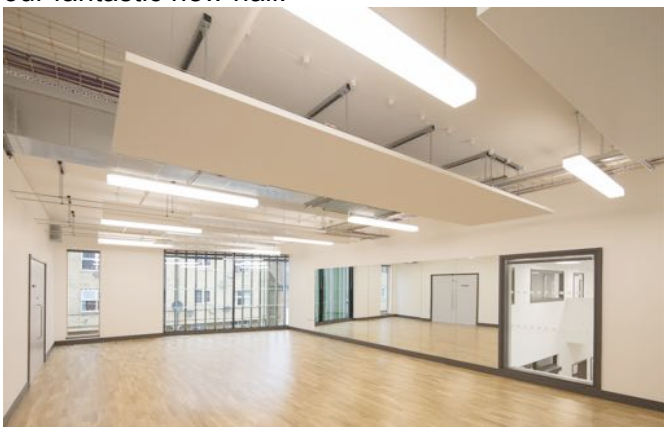


Newsletter November 2017
