Sports Premium 2013/2014

The Government is providing £150 million per annum for the academic years 2013/14, 2014/15 and 2015/16 to provide new funding for primary school sport. The funding is jointly provided by the Department for Education, Health and Culture and Media and Sport. Money is paid directly to schools, for schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. Each school receives £8000 plus an additional £5 per pupils each year. This means at Albion we receive around £9,000 a year. Schools must spend the sports funding on improving their provision for PE and sport, whilst having the freedom to decide how they do this.

The school used the funding to support activities below:

Membership of the London PE & School Sport Network based at Bacons College, Rotherhithe

Running after school sports clubs (Dance / Tag Rugby / Athletics / Cricket / Volley Ball)

Increasing participation in inter school festivals and competitions (Football / Tag Rugby / Rugby / Virtual Games)

Additional teacher at swimming lessons

Double Club with Millwall FC

Purchase of additional equipment
